(‘POINT to POINT’ MEETINGS DO NOT QUALIFY FOR THIS SCHEME)

(PLEASE NOTE)

(THIS IS FOR THE 53rd LEVY PERIOD ~ 1st APRIL 2014 – 31st MARCH 2015)

For the **53rd Levy period (1st April 2014 – 31st March 2015)** AGT authorised bookmakers who produce for the FRB a relevant **‘Notice of Assessment and Certificate of Discharge’** will be paid a proportion of their ‘levy liability paid’ (levy plus attendance fees), the percentage of which will be determined at a later date when the total amount of claims is known.

The relevant **‘Notice of Assessment and Certificate of Discharge’** should be sent by **Post, Fax or Email to Brian Newland by 30th April 2016.**

A copy of this letter will also be posted on the FRB, ARB, NAB, RBA, and AGT web-sites in November 2015 and local associations will be asked to remind their members of the deadline.

It is essential that Members obtain confirmation that their application has been received. *(Posted applications must include a stamped addressed envelope).* If confirmation of receipt has not been received within two weeks, enquiries should be made on the above telephone number as to whether the required documents have been received by the FRB. Failure to do so could result in non payment.

As a consequence of the above arrangements, claims that applications have been lost in the post or that bookmakers were unaware of the scheme will not be accepted.

It will not be possible to make a payment to anyone who fails to supply the above information by 30th April 2016 or to bookmakers who only bet at ‘point to point’.

Late submissions will be considered **only** on the basis of medical grounds or failure to receive a ‘Notice of Assessment and Certificate of Discharge’ from the Levy Board due to on-going litigation.
